





Table 2 & Figure 2: the table and figure showing department wise number ofstudents participating in Student Satisfaction Survey







Table 4 & Figure 4: the table and figure showing students' responses regardingquality of course content



Table 5 & Figure 5: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding thecompletion of course






 Table 7 & Figure 7: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding library support in the college





 Table 8 & Figure 8: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding studentteacher relationship








 Table 12 & Figure 12: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding overall Rating of the College
