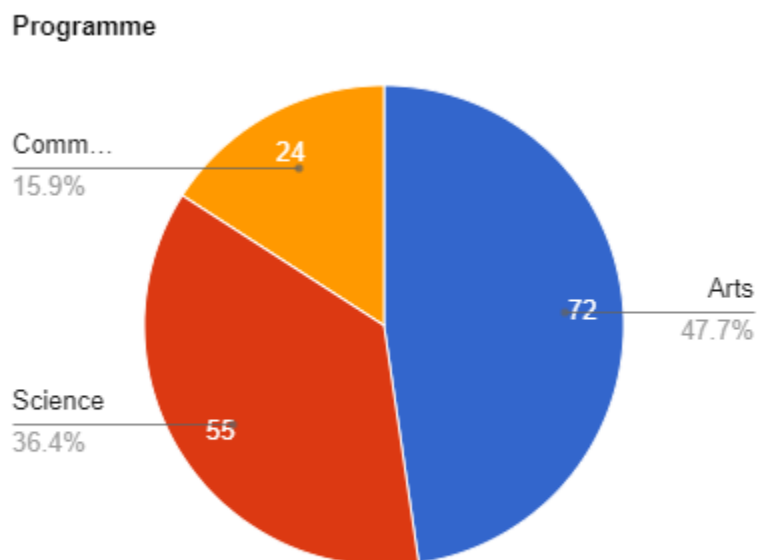


Table 1 & Figure 1: the table and figure showing number of students participating programme wise in Student Satisfaction Survey

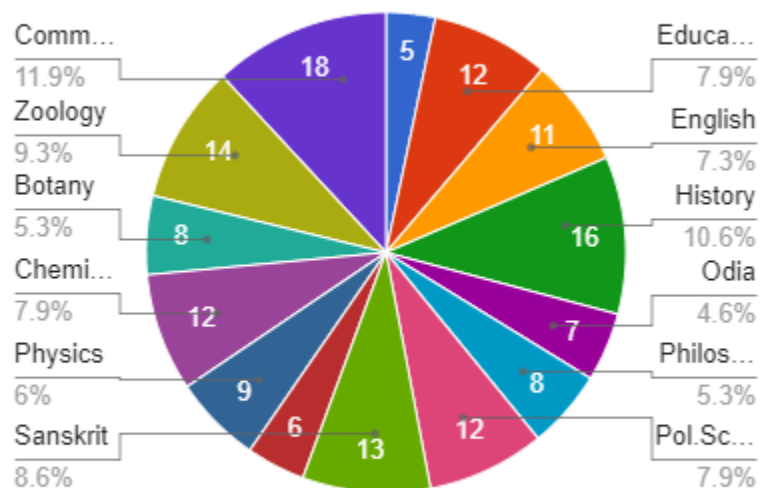


Table 2 & Figure 2: the table and figure showing department wise number of students participating in Student Satisfaction Survey

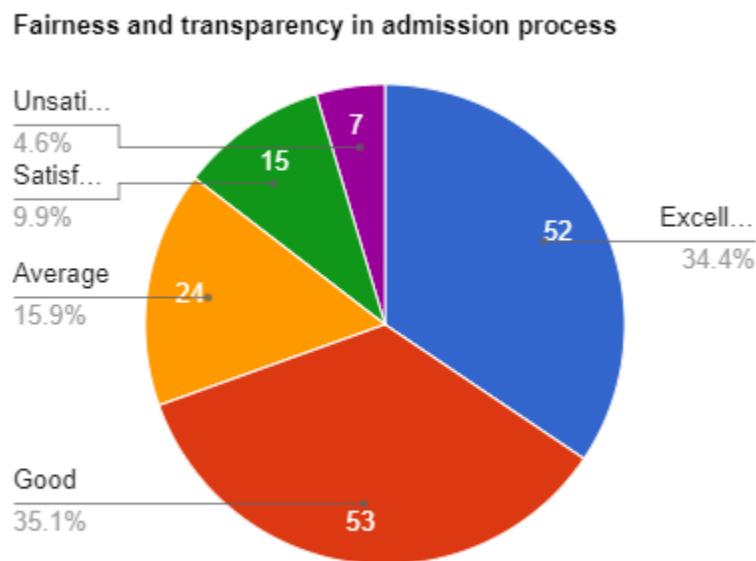


Table 3 & Figure 3: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding admission process

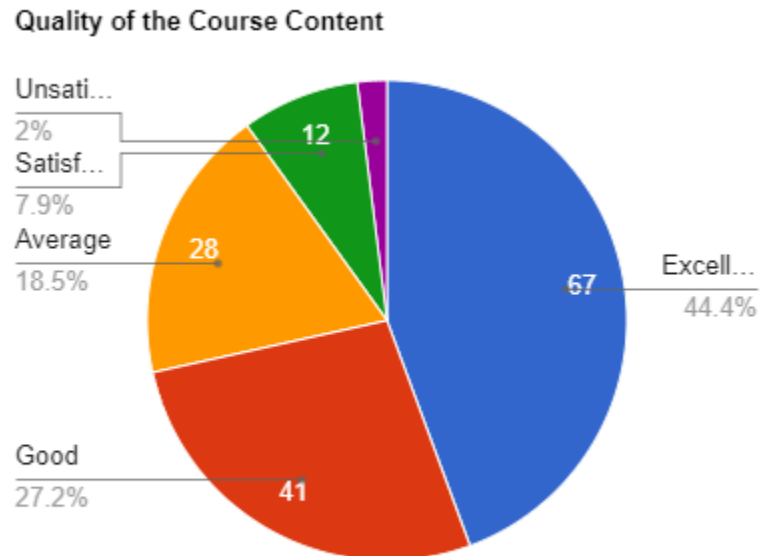


Table 4 & Figure 4: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding quality of course content

Analysis & interpretation: Responses received against quality of course content has been recorded. It is seen that 44.4% students found course content excellent, 27.2% found good, 18.5% students found average, 7.9% students found satisfied, and 2% found unsatisfactory.

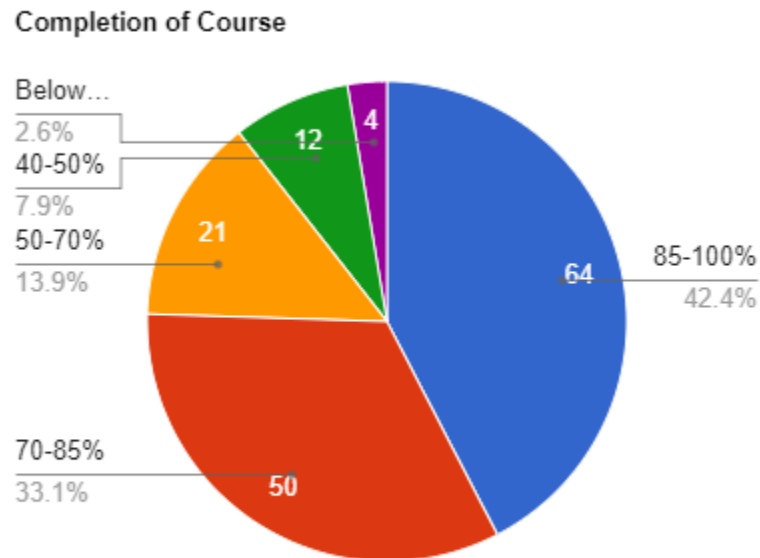


Table 5 & Figure 5: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding the completion of course

Analysis & interpretation: Responses received against completion of course has been recorded. 64 responses indicate that that course has been completed 85-100% whereas 50 responses are in favour of 70-85% course completion. 21 responses indicate that the course has been completed from 50-70% while 12 responses are in favour of 40-50% course completion. Only 4 responses indicate that the course has been completed below 40%.

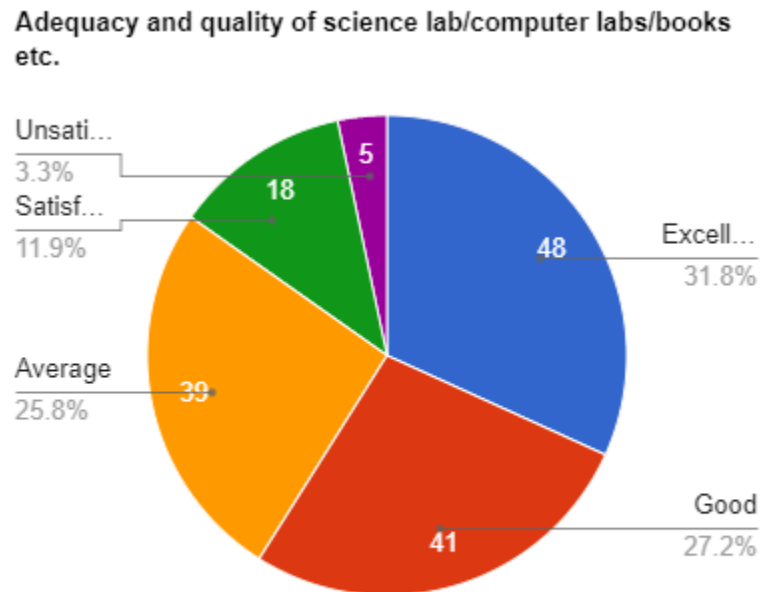


Table 6 & Figure 6: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding adequacy and quality of science lab/computer labs/books

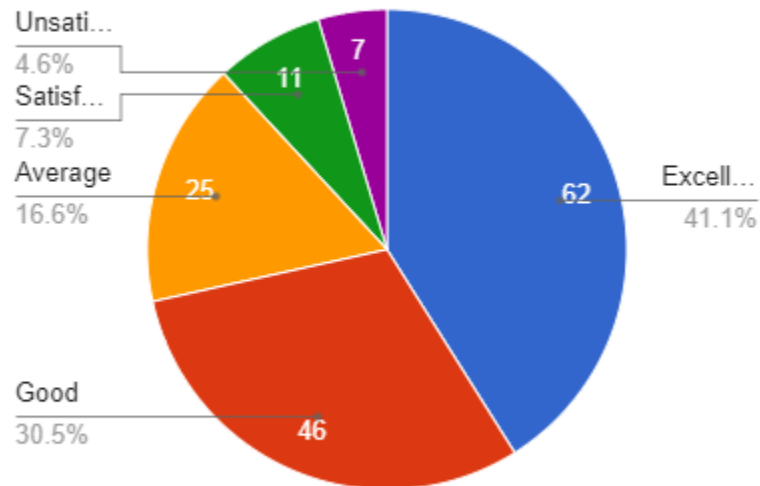


Table 7 & Figure 7: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding library support in the college

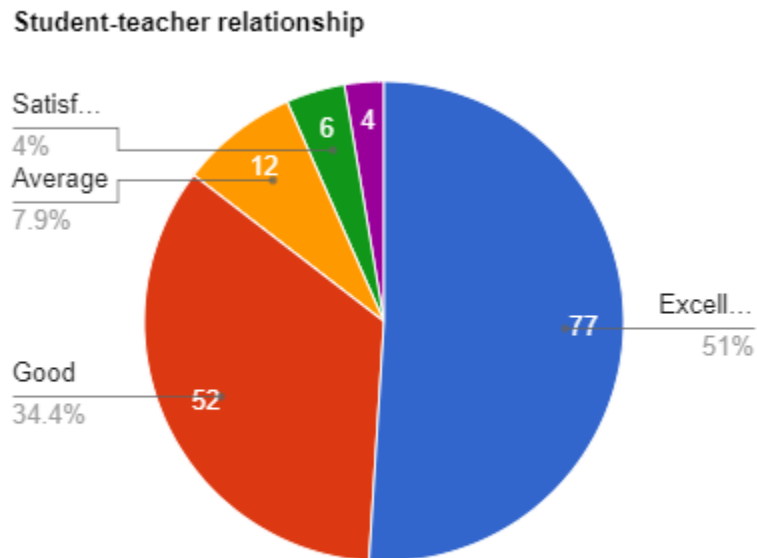


Table 8 & Figure 8: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding student-teacher relationship

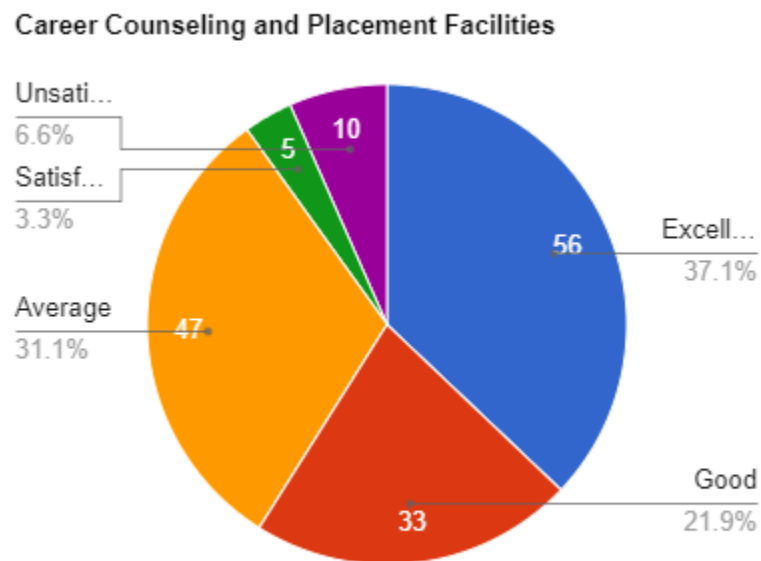


Table 9 & Figure 9: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding career counseling and placement facilities

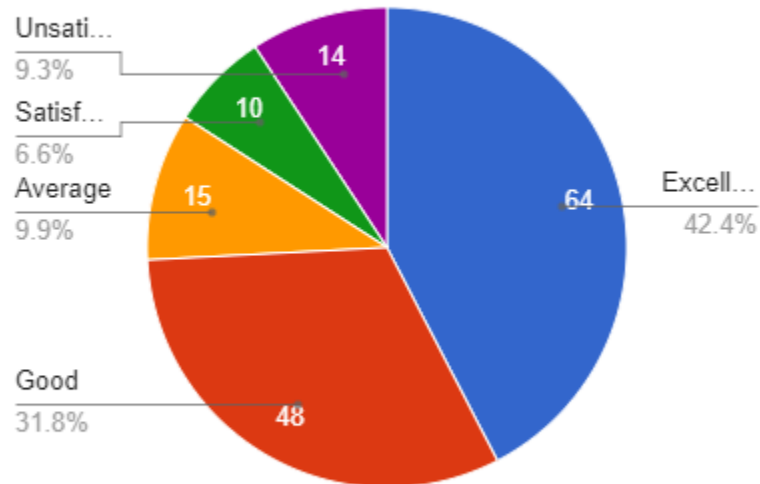


Table 10 & Figure 10: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding multiple opportunities to learn and grow

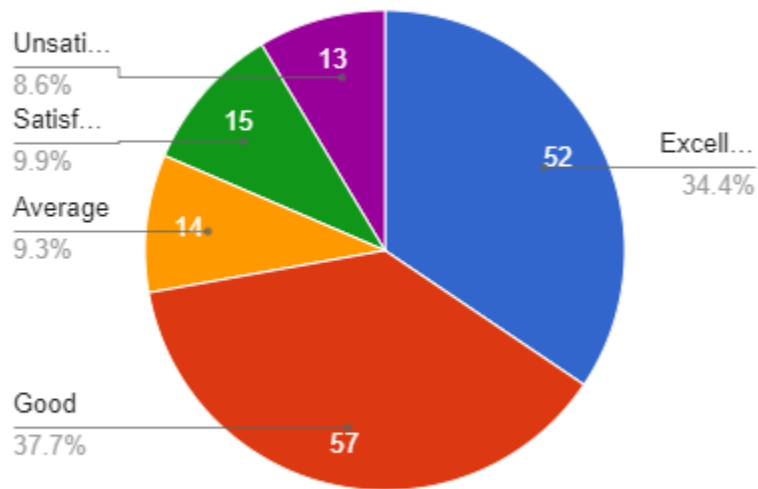


Table 11 & Figure 11: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding opportunities in the field of extra-curricular activities

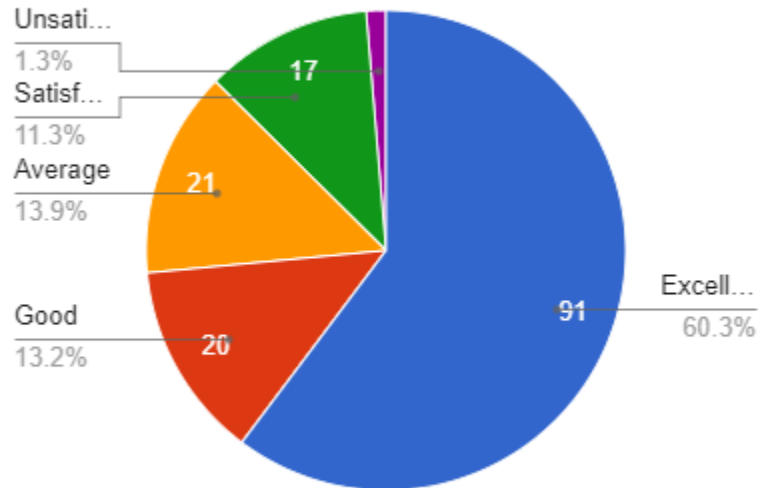


Table 12 & Figure 12: the table and figure showing students' responses regarding overall Rating of the College

The Student Satisfactory Survey for the session 2019-20 provided us insights in various fields. Students' responses in the fields of admission process, course content, library support, student-teacher relationship, extra-curricular activities, and overall performance of the institution are excellent, and good. Because of the untimely outbreak of COVID-19 towards the end of 2019-20 session, the responses in the field of course completion in physical mode seems to be slightly lower than earlier.
